



# ABOUT KidSwing

The KidSwing Golf Tournament was founded in 2003 by former Texas Scottish Rite Hospital for Children patient, Ben Sater. When he discovered that patients receive treatment regardless of the family's ability to pay, he decided to use his love for golf to give back to the hospital. He created KidSwing, a 9-hole, best-ball scramble, for players ages 5 to 18 of all levels of golf ability.

KidSwing is a unique fundraising concept that is unparalleled. Unlike other charity golf tournaments, KidSwing is all about kids helping kids. The event also gives local businesses and corporations the opportunity to help. There is no entry fee to play in the tournament, but players are asked to raise at least \$100 by asking their friends and families to sponsor them. Since its inception, KidSwing has raised more than \$2 million for Scottish Rite Hospital!
